



Ford dévoile les prix de la Mustang MACH-E

Berchem-Sainte-Agathe, le 28 mai 2020 – Ford dévoile les prix de son premier véhicule entièrement électrique, le crossover Mustang MACH-E.

Au Grand-Duché de Luxembourg, la Ford Mustang MACH-E « Standard Range » sera disponible dès 46.413 euros (TVAc). Celle-ci compte sur 450 km d'autonomie grâce à sa batterie de 76 kWh.

La déclinaison « Extended Range », avec les 600 km d'autonomie fournis par la batterie de 99 kWh débute à 54.293 € (TVAc).

Standard Range et Extended Range peuvent être équipées de la transmission intégrale, avec des prix débutant alors à 53.133 et 62.295 euros.

Les carnets de commandes sont désormais ouverts et les premières livraisons sont attendues pour le début 2021. Plus d'infos chez les distributeurs Ford.
