What’s more, the participating Mustang owners will celebrate their pride and joy with a deep Mustang bath offering a special merchandise pack, meet and greet with Ford Performance drivers (including Belgian GT3 driver Fred Vervisch), pit box tours, photo session, and very “Mustang prizes” to win...
