



EN BREF – Ceinture de sécurité gonflable en première sur la nouvelle Mondeo

Berchem-Sainte-Agathe, le 21 juin 2012 – La nouvelle Mondeo qui débutera l'année prochaine, sera la première voiture qui pourra disposer de ceintures de sécurité gonflables pour les passagers à l'arrière. Cette technologie de sécurité combine un airbag et une ceinture de sécurité classique et est conçue pour éviter les blessures de tête, cou et poitrine des passagers à l'arrière. En cas d'accident, la ceinture est gonflée afin de répandre les forces de collision sur tout le corps, une surface cinq fois plus grande que celle d'une ceinture classique.
