Berchem-Sainte-Agathe, le 19 juin 2013 – Entre 2000 et 2012, Ford a diminué les émissions CO₂ de 37% par véhicule. Pour 2025, Ford mise sur une réduction supplémentaire de 30% en introduisant de nouveaux produits et de nouvelles technologies ainsi que des méthodes de production plus écologiques. C'est ce qui révèle le quatorzième « Sustainability Report 2013 » annuel de Ford, qui vient d'être publié et contient des informations sur les initiatives durables sur le plan social, économique et environnemental.

The first Ford cars were shipped to Europe in 1903 – the same year Ford Motor Company was founded. European production started in 1911.*

Ford Belgium (Brussels) distributes Ford vehicles and Ford original parts in Belgium & Luxemburg, since 1922. Ford Genk produces all large cars (Mondeo, S-MAX, Galaxy) for Ford in Europe, with 4.300 employees. Ford Lommel Proving Ground is the lead test facility for validation of all Ford models in Europe, with 350 employees.
